Nandipur Power Project is a 425 MW combined cycle thermal power plant situated at Nandipur near Gujranwala in the Punjab province of Pakistan. Being constructed by the China Dongfang Electric Corporation, the project was completed in March 2015.



In January 2008, Pakistan Electric Power Company (PEPCO) signed a Rs. 23 billion (\$329 million) contract with Dong Fang Electric Corporation of China to construct the Nandipur Power Project and paid it a 10 per cent down payment. By mid-2010, much of the work at this power project was complete and it was expected be finished on schedule in April 2011.

However, the project suffered delays as the summary, sent by the Ministry of Water and Power for legal opinion of the Ministry of Law & Justice, remained pending with the latter for two years from March 2010 to March 2012. - All costs are denoted in PKR (Pakistan Rupees).
- The costs mentioned are exclusive of all taxes. Any applicable taxes such as GST (Goods and Services Tax) will be charged separately to operators, members, or companies in addition to the agreed assessable prices.
- A withholding tax (WHT) of 10% will be applied, and no exemption certificates, including PEC (Pakistan Engineering Council) or any other exempted certificate, will be accepted.
- The item rates are locked exclusively for the participating companies of the DKTCC Project.
- As per the Steering Committee's final list of segment-wise member participants and segment length, it has been decided that each Consortium Member will issue a Purchase Order (PO) to the selected Vendor.
- Prior to the commencement of Civil work, all Operators are required to submit a cheque as an advance payment of 90% of the Purchase Order (PO) amount to the Steering Committee/Coordination Company.
- The Steering Committee/Coordination Company will release payments for the Civil works based on the Purchase Order (PO) amount, with 90% disbursed in two instalments. 80% will be released upon completion of the reinstatement work, and the remaining 10% will be released after the Cable Pulling process.
- Cheques/payments will be released to the Vendor upon the completion of every 5 kilometers of Civil work, which includes both the reinstatement and cable pulling processes.
- A security deposit of 10% will be retained within the consortium as a precautionary measure and will be released six months after the completion of the work.
- In the event that a Non-Member duct is laid within the same trench with the approval of the competent authority and consent of the Consortium, the corresponding charges will be based on a single duct rate. Out of the total amount, 50% will be allocated to the Civil Work Vendor, while the remaining 50% will be adjusted against payments due from consortium members.
- In the event that a new member joins the DKTCC at any phase, their share of Civil Work shall be twice that of the existing consortium members.

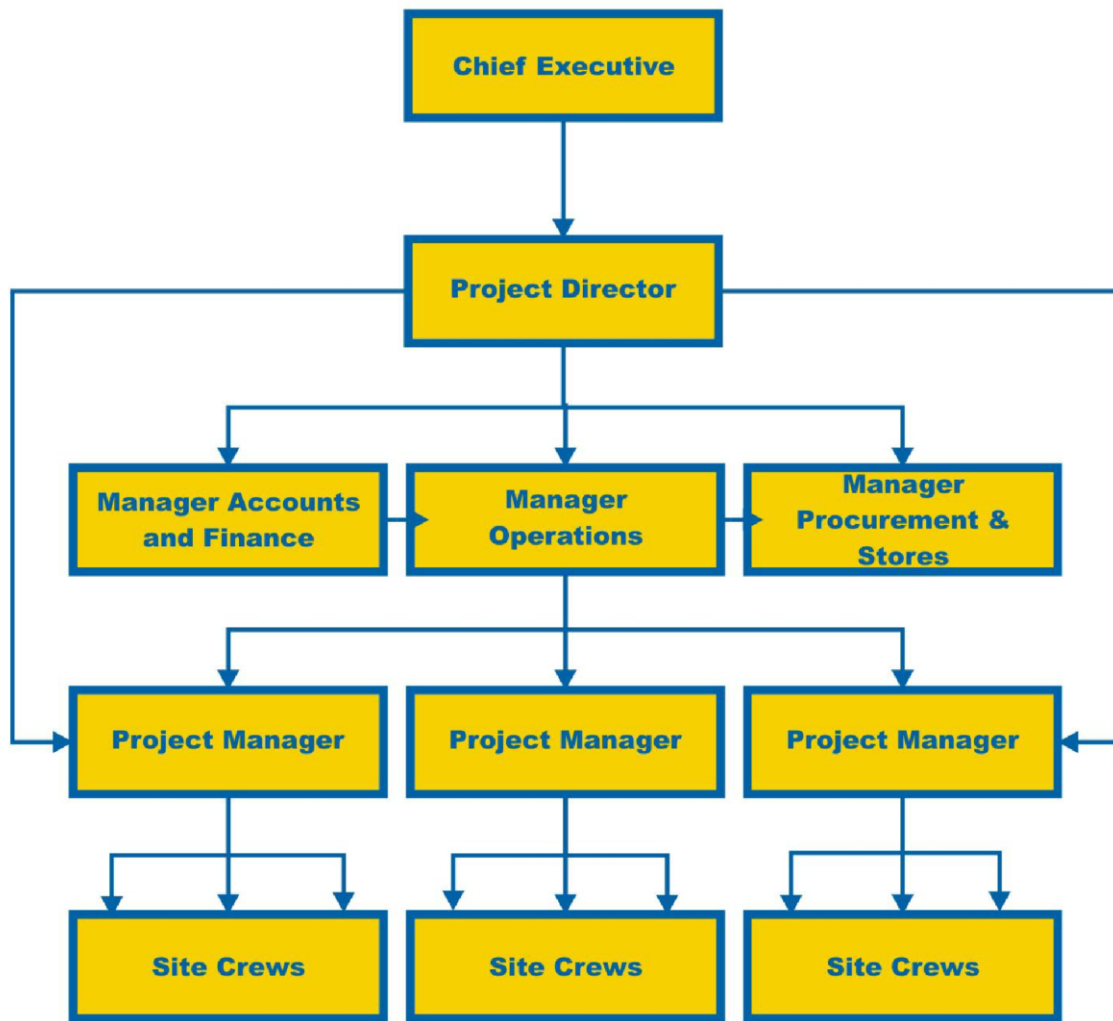
